Create your own pollinator habitat!

- Diversity is key!
- Plant flowers with different bloom periods to provide for both insects that are active early in the year and those that are active in the fall.
- Aim for 3-5 species for each season.
- Include different flower colors and flower shapes.
- Plant both annual and perennial plants.
- Include perennial grasses, which add nesting material for bees and may be host plants to caterpillars.

Benefits of using perennial plants in your landscape:

- Provide floral resources yearly (some perennials take several years before they produce flowers – just be patient with them)
- Many can survive on lower amounts of water (once established)
- Lower maintenance in the long term since there is less of a need to replant each year.
